INSTALLATION WITH STANDARD HAMMER



Firmly set one side of the EZLOG Hog

Nose Staple onto the log spanning
the end split. Drive the staple in using
alternating hits on the opposing ends of
the product. Do not strike the center.

USE CAUTION! Continue "walking" the staple into the log until it is fully seated.






Hold the stenciled side of **EZLOG Hog Nose Staple**™ up to the magnetic base of the EZLOG Precision

Installation Tool.



The staple should seat evenly in the pocket and be held by the high strength magnet.

To get the maximum benefit from the **Hog Nose Staple Pressure Tabs**™ align the red arrow and index mark over the split as a centering guide.

Solidly impact the striking point of the tool with a hammer (3-4 lb. non-slip grip sledgehammer is recommended). Use caution to avoid striking any unprotected portion of the wrist or hand. Leather gloves are recommended for safety.

- Strike the tool as many times as necessary to drive the base of the installation tool completely to or near the log face (usually two or three hits). Safety goggles are recommended for both user and bystanders.
- 7 If the EZLOG Hog Nose Staple™ is not fully seated, simply strike the opposing ends of the staple if desired to complete the install. Avoid striking the center of the staple in order to allow easy insertion of the removal tool when necessary.





REMOVAL

Insert pry bar, single claw hammer, cat's paw, screwdriver or similar tool into the center slot of the staple. A rolling pry bar works best. Use the tool to walk or roll the staple from the log.

In some cases, it may be necessary to work the staple partially out from each side and not just from the center. Wear gloves to pull free if needed.
